Upon the world reopening, Lewis and Euan have taken their collection across the ponds and borders, with regular stops in London, Ibiza, Paris and a tour in Brazil. Bringing it back to where it all started, they run a successful club night of their own at Sneaky Pete's. Each night in the sweat box has been wall to wall with loving spirit and smiles. Of the guest DJ's they have invited from across the scene, each have left feeling revived with faith in local scenes and an enhanced passion for good quality music and parties. This is accompanied with a bi-monthly radio show

on Edinburgh based station, EHFM, where similarly, guests from across the world and digging scene have contributed.

Sweet and humble as individuals, they deliver that energy with some added tenacity when behind the controls. Regardless of setting whether it's a listening bar, festival or thronged out club, they know how to make people bask in the bliss or rollick in the rave for the duration.
